

0-9 NUMBER CHART

This 0-9 Number Chart is an important tool for re-teaching the proper patterns of maths and including 0 as a number and a place holder.

One of the main reasons students struggle to learn maths is because we, as teachers, give them no foundational understanding of WHAT they are doing. Why would we include 0 in this number line, as opposed to other number lines and sequencing which start with 1?

Well, because 0 is a number and it's a place holder. When introducing your student to Place Value, this understanding is important. The number 105 is NOT 15 - the zero holds the place value of the "tens house" even if there are not any tens there.

Remember, when teaching maths, it's important to use multisensory and hands-on tools as the key component of teaching effective maths. Using the Integer Blocks along with this teaching icreates a strong understanding of Place Value and is key to creating a solid foundation in maths.

This template can be used as a stand-alone resource and also works well with the Maths Australia teaching instructions and manipulatives.
