1. Build It
"Show me with the blocks."
2. Draw It
"Show me the representational drawing of what you built with the blocks."
3. Write It
"Write down the problem and the answer."
4. Say It
"Explain the problem and how you got your answer."
5. Teach it Back
"Teach that back to me and let me learn."
